


CENTENNIAL CHAPTER ENDOWMENT PROGRAM


CHAPTER ENDOWMENT DETAILS

The threshold to begin a chapter endowment fund is \$10,000, which may be reached over a period of five years.

National Office staff members will gladly help with a strategy that includes an assessment of current chapter funding, a review of alumni information and identification of lead donors. Your chapter will complete a fund agreement clarifying your intention and formalizing the expectation that the minimum amount of \$10,000 will be reached within five years.

The annual distribution set by the MBNF at the present time is 3.5 percent per year based on the average earnings of the fund over 12 quarters. So, a chapter with a \$10,000 endowment receives \$350 a year.



Leadership Initiatives



3. open new channels for alumni to engage with collegiate members.


