About Mortar Board

Mortar Board was **founded in 1918** as an interdisciplinary honor society for college senior women. Under Title IX, the Society began accepting men in 1975, adding to its purpose "to emphasize the advancement of the status of women" and "to promote equal opportunities among all peoples."

Mortar Board has been a **certified member** of the Association of College Honor Societies since 1937 and follows the Council for the Advancement of Standards in Higher Education for Collegiate Honor Society Programs.

Mortar Board has chartered 235 chapters nationwide, with over 100 active today and welcoming 3,000 new members annually. With an alumni network of over 300,000, Mortar Board's people are its greatest asset.

Why Mortar Board?


