Now What... Practice Humility

Leadership is not about being the loudest in the room, it's about influencing and uplifting others around you.

Ways to Model Humility in Leadership:

- Prioritize Collaboration over Control
- Give Credit Generously and Often

- 🞉 Celebrate Team Wins, Big and Small
- Connect with Others as People First, not just Roles


